

COMMUNITY EDUCATION GRANT

Overview

Beta Nu is the Sequim chapter of the Delta Kappa Gamma Society, an honorary society for key women educators. We are keenly aware of the need for educators to improve student learning. Beta Nu members have dedicated themselves to helping fulfill the purposes of our society by supporting well-trained educators in promoting excellence in scholarship and education.

To this end, grants will be given to non-profit agencies for educational projects serving people living in areas served by the Sequim and Port Angeles School districts.

The grants are given in memory of Isabelle Whitfield, Helen Haller Heimbaugh, and Helen Gariepy, longtime educators in Clallam County and members of Beta Nu Chapter.

Who is Eligible and Conditions

- This is for community education projects of non-profit agencies.
- This grant is for educational projects for people living in areas served by the Sequim and Port Angeles School districts.
- The grant must be implemented by a qualified educator.
- No amount is guaranteed and funding is at the sole discretion of Beta Nu Chapter, The Delta Kappa Gamma Society International.
- There is no restriction as to gender or ethnic background.
- Grants will be awarded on a one-time basis, but consideration will be given to recurring projects.
- The non-profit agency will provide a follow-up written report to Beta Nu Chapter.

How to Apply

1. Complete the “Community Education Grant” application form, which is available online at www.BetaNuChapter.com
2. Include with the application:
 - A cover letter which includes:
 - A brief (100-200 words) educational vision of the agency
 - The title of your project
 - A very brief statement that: 1) you agree to submitting a short follow-up report of how the organization met the goals of this project, and 2) you understand this follow-up report is due no later than one month after the conclusion of the project.
 - Project information:
 - Overall goal(s) of this specific project
 - Description of the project
 - Timeline (include whether it is a one-time or recurring project)
 - Complete the form, “Line Item Breakdown,” to include a description and breakdown of costs, including but not limited to a) equipment, b) consumables, and c) staffing
 - Funding received or expected from other sources
 - Numbers served
 - Cities of residency of those served
 - Resume of educator implementing the project
 - Completed form, “Organization Release Form for News and Media Recording,” agreeing to media coverage
3. Mail the completed application, postmarked **on or before October 15 or May 15 to:**
